

# Comparing Adjectives

When we compare **two** nouns we use a comparative adjective.  
e.g. Emma is **strong**. Amy is **stronger**.

When we compare **three** or more adjectives we use a superlative adjective.  
e.g. Emma is **strong**. Amy is **stronger**. Sue is the **strongest**.
