The life-cycle of a flowering plant

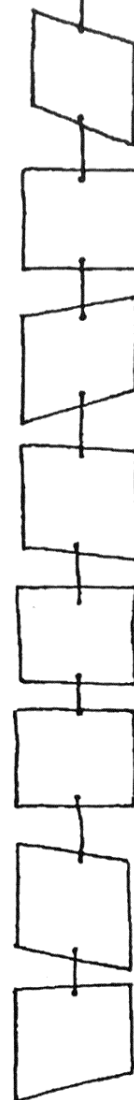
You will need: scissors; glue; card; cotton thread; colouring pencils.
