Sometimes when we are talking about people or things we use **pronouns** instead of **nouns**.



me

Pronouns may be **singular** (one person or thing).



you

The pronoun **you** may be **singular**.



us

Pronouns may be **plural** (more than one person or thing).



you

The pronoun **you** may be **plural**.
