11. For titles used before Proper Names.

Examples: Prince Charles; Lord Nelson; Sir Francis Drake

12. For the names of God and Jesus Christ, as well as for pronouns relating to Them.

Examples: The Saviour; The Messiah; He is our strength; Hallowed be Thy name

13. To begin every line of poetry

Example: Day after day, day after day,
We stuck, nor breath nor motion;
As idle as a painted ship
Upon a painted ocean.
