

Short forms

The short way of writing **has not** is **hasn't**.

We can also write **that is** a short way – **that's**.

In a similar way the word **will** can be added to words and written in a short way.

I will	I'll
you will	you'll
he will	he'll
she will	she'll
we will	we'll
they will	they'll

Remember that the ' shows that the letters **wi** have been left out.
