

The Story of Coffee

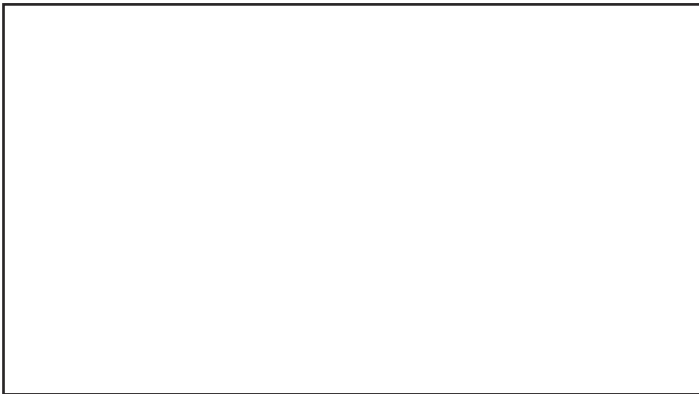
L.O: To learn a famous Colombian export.

1. After 2 to 4 years, the coffee plant will produce a small white blossom.



2. The blossom drops off and is replaced with green berries.



3. When the coffee beans are ready they turn red. The coffee bean lives inside the berry.



4. The harvest lasts for 6 months starting in December and the beans are picked by hand.

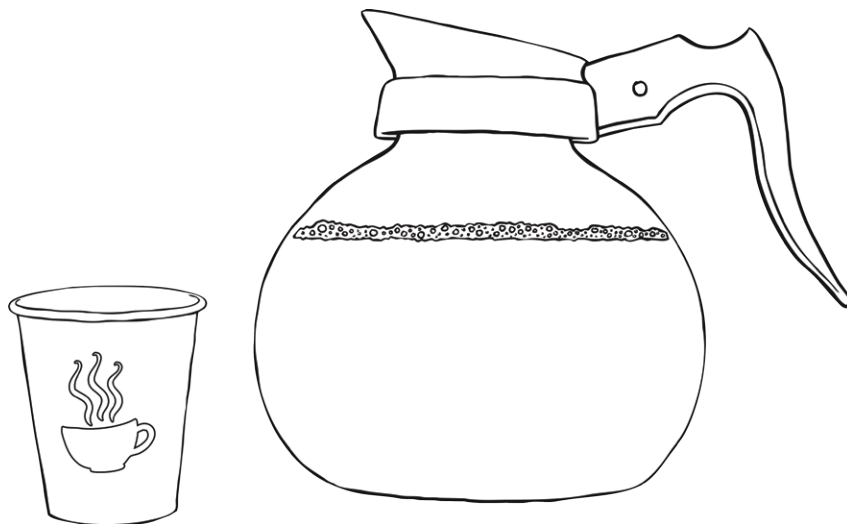
Write sentences and illustrate your work

5. The beans are removed from the berry and dried. The beans are green at this stage.

6. The coffee beans are roasted which gives the their dark brown colour.

7. The beans are ground down and this is what is mixed with hot water.

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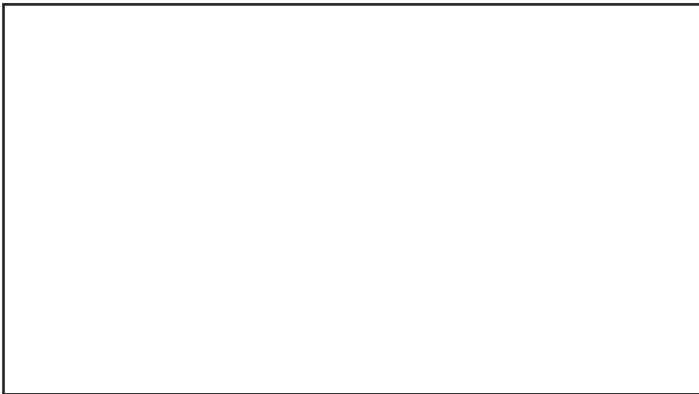
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
