Chimera (ki-meer-uh)



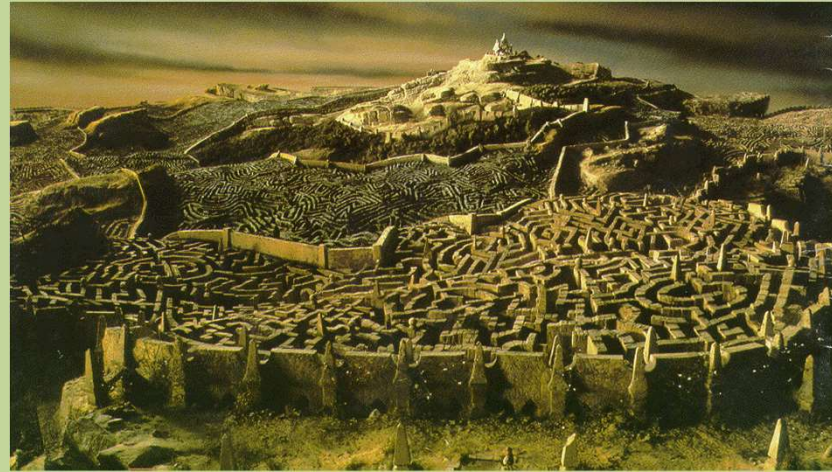
- It had the head of a lion, the body of a goat and the tail of a dragon.
