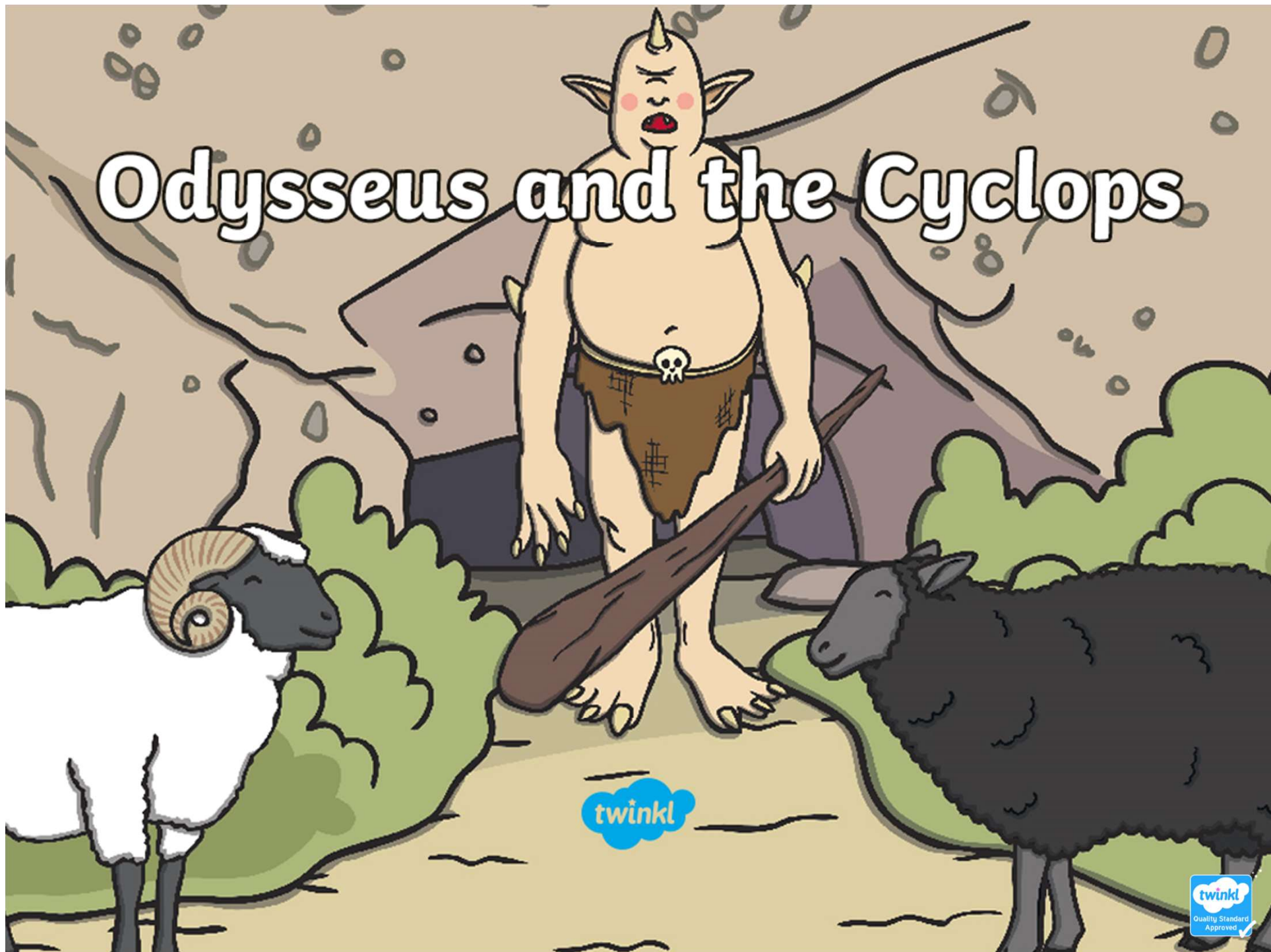


Odysseus and the Cyclops

who was as big as a house.



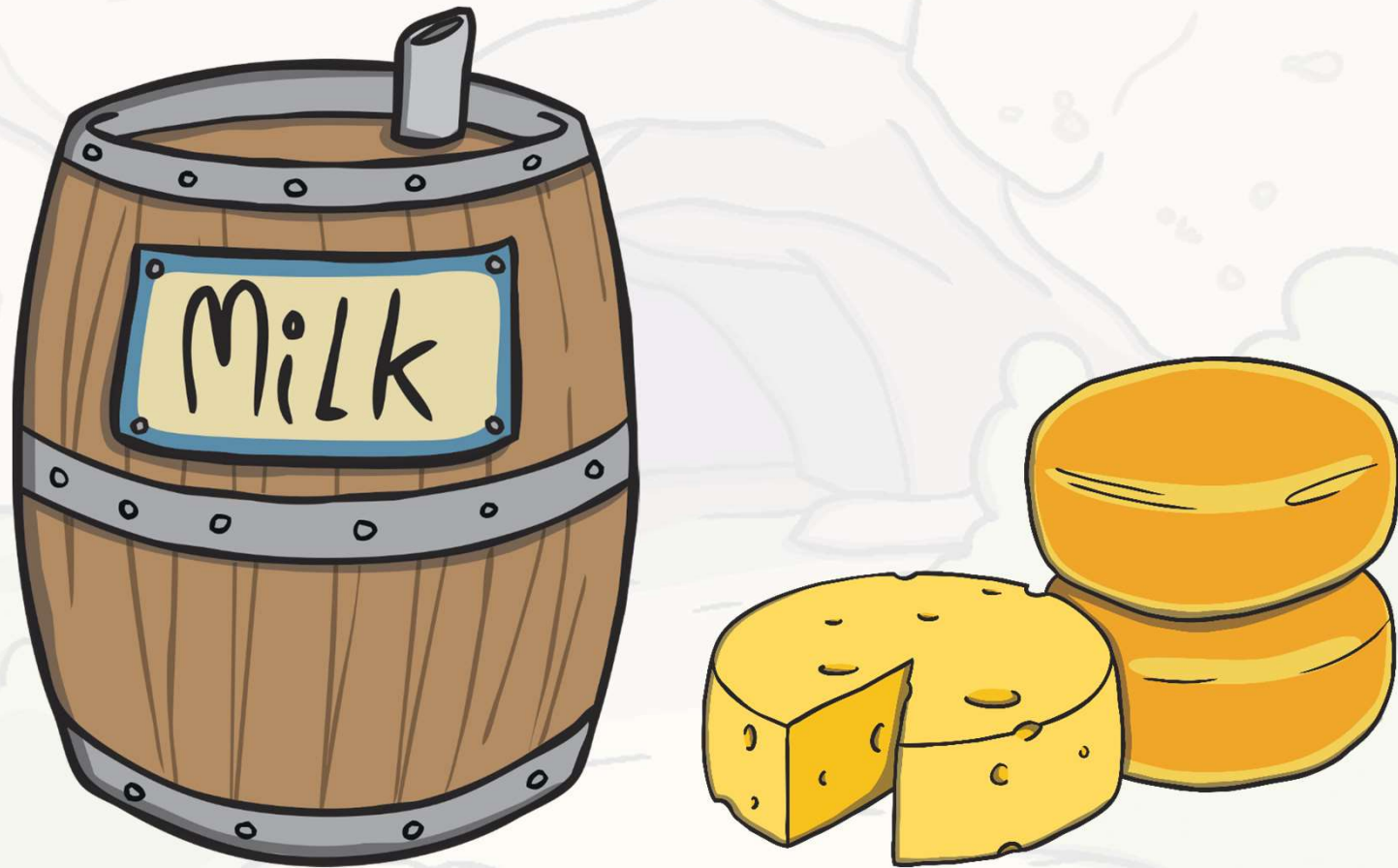
One day, a man called Odysseus and his 12 men came to the island.
