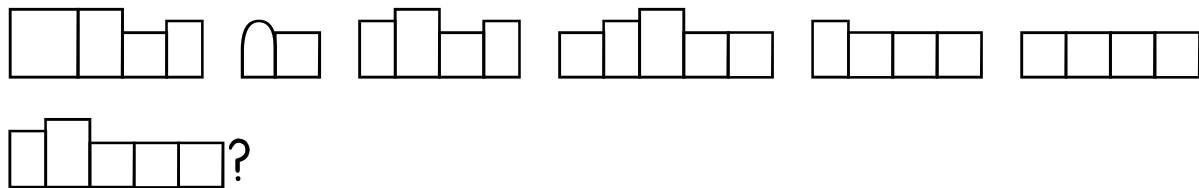
tree + 1 to mean one more than two

with + 1 for someone who makes spells

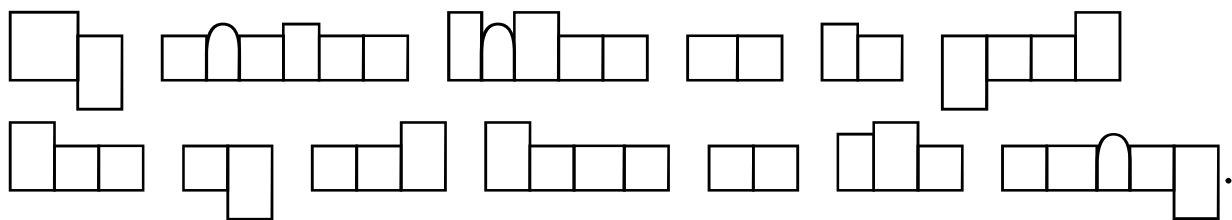
