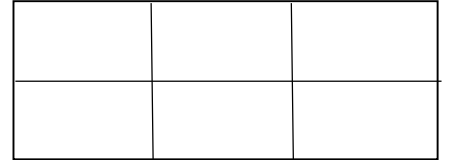


WW2 Art Lesson – Wassily Kandinsky

This week we are going to have a look at a famous Russian artist called Wassily Kandinsky. He is famous for abstract art and was creating these pieces of art around the time of WW1 and WW2.

You will need paints, felt tips, crayons or colouring pencils.

If you prefer you can use a paint package on your computer to create a picture.



First of all you need to rule your page into 6 boxes.

Paint or draw a dot in the centre of each square. Use a different colour for each one.

Around each dot paint a circle in a different colour.

Around each circle paint a bigger circle in a new colour.

Finally fill in any white space you have in each square in another colour.
