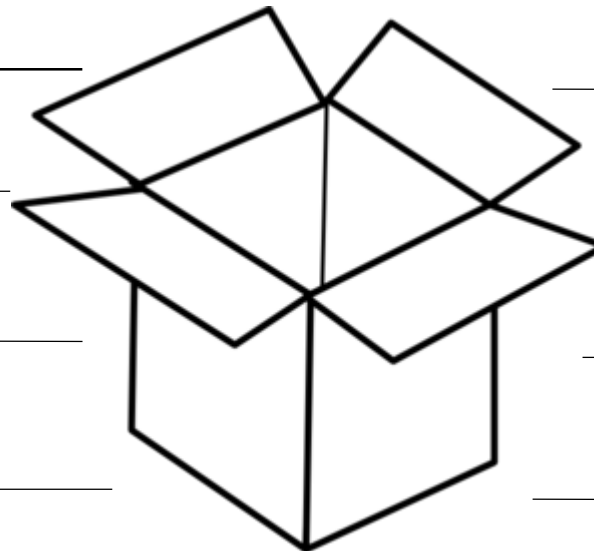
Food to snack on - but remember food rationing

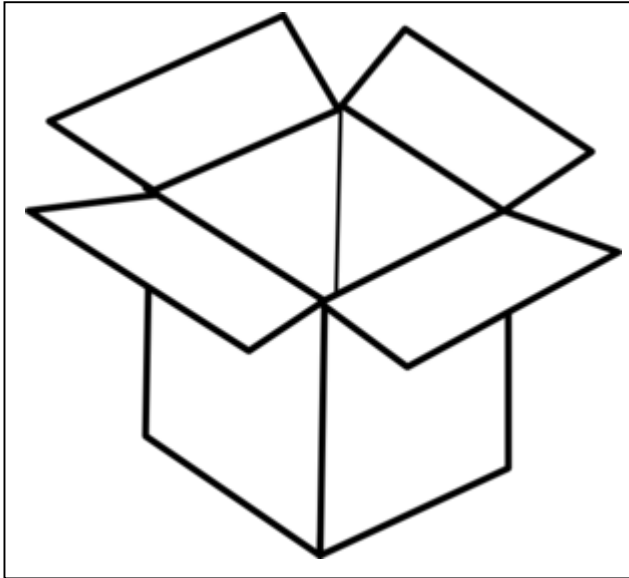
