

Finn McCool's Rock Path Challenge

Can you help Finn reach the enemy giant, Benandonner, who is across the water, using hexagon-shaped rocks?

Remember that in order to make sure that Finn doesn't fall into the water, you must make sure to **tessellate** the hexagon shapes. This means that you must make sure each hexagon is touching. To make sure Finn has enough space to step, all of your hexagons must share at least two sides with other hexagons.

Cut out the hexagon that you have been provided with and use it as a stencil to help you draw and tessellate your hexagon rocks so you can reach Benandonner.
