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LO: to convert weights (1- continued)

But what happens if you only have half a kilogram? How do you write this? How do you convert it to grams?

Remember 1 whole kg is 1000g, so half of 1000g is 500g.

Half a kilogram is sometimes shown like this >>>> 0.5kg.

So...

1.5 kg = 1500 g so that means that... 1500 g = 1.5 kg

2.5 kg = 2500 g so that means that... 2500 g = 2.5 kg
