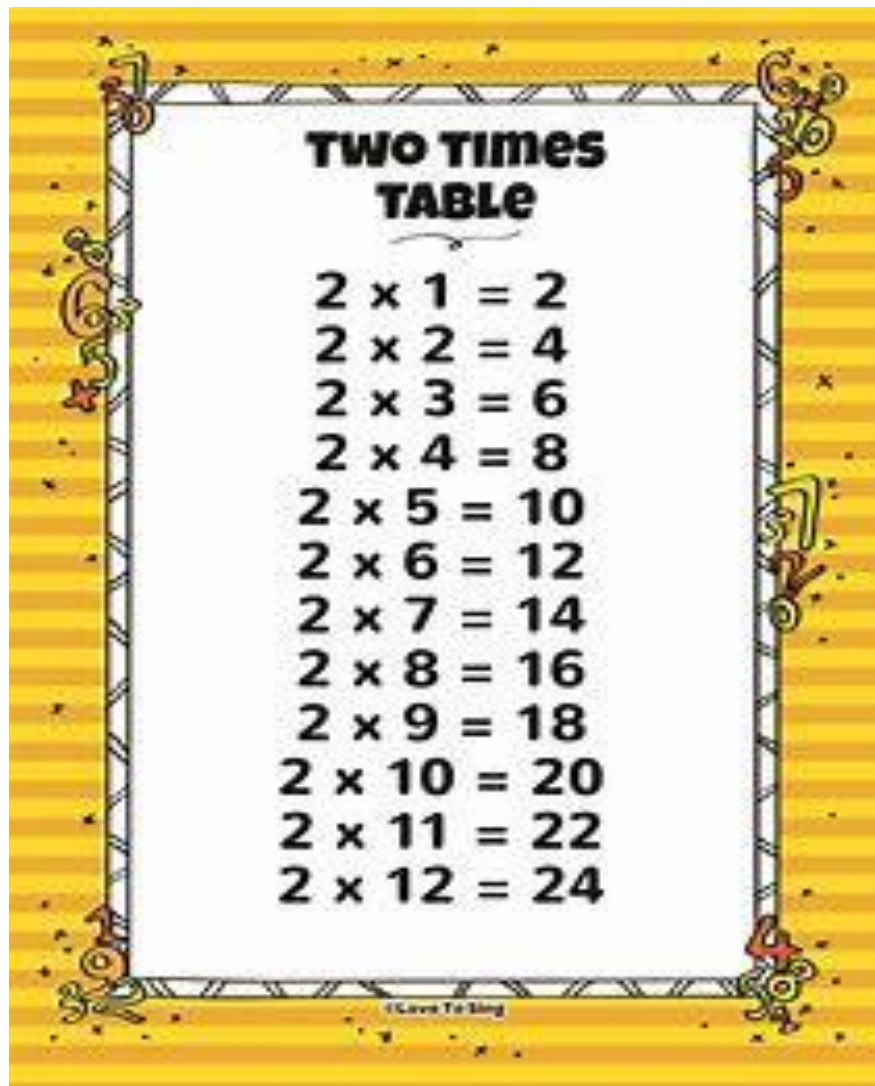
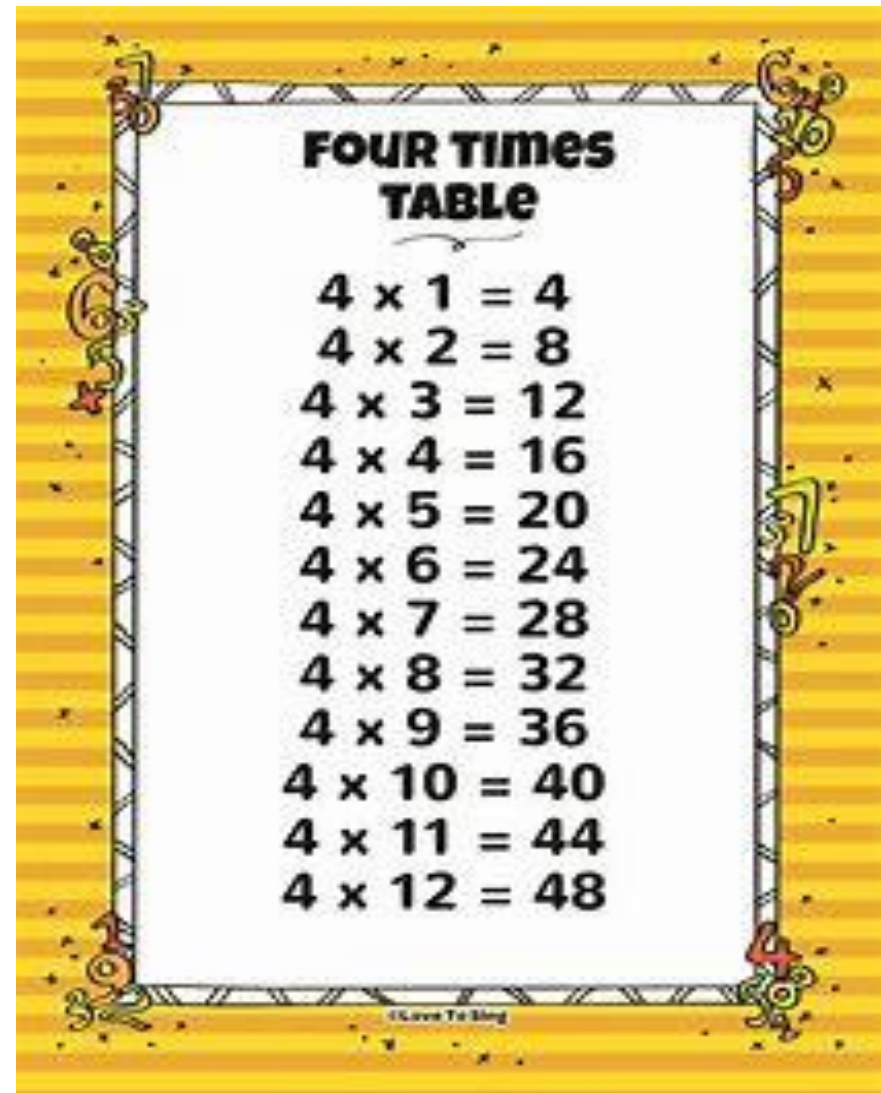


Multiplying by 2 and 4. The 2 times table is very similar to the 4 times table. Can you notice a pattern?
