This week we are working on place value, part part whole (missing values) and using known facts to solve calculations.

If I know..... Then I know....

Example: Adding a 1 digit number to a two digit number

$$23 + 5 =$$

If I know $3 + 5 = 8$

Then I know $23 + 5 = 28$

Example: Adding tens

$$30 + 50 =$$

If I know $3 + 5 = 8$

Then I know

$$30 + 50 = 80$$
