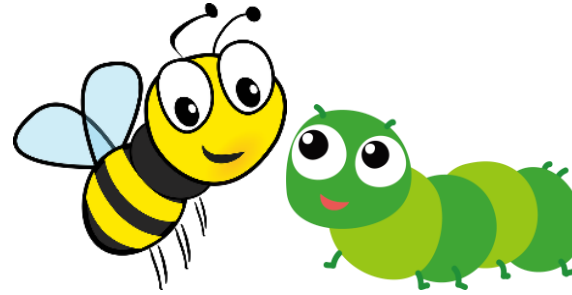


Week 5 Bees and Caterpillars



Welcome to week 5. Thank you so much for all of last week's fabulous work. This week we will continue our work on data collection. Your child will revise and look at; Pictograms Tally charts simple tables block diagrams

Things to think about

Tally charts: If they forget, remind your child to cross the tally when they reach a multiple of five. If your child counts each tally individually you could remind them that they can count in fives as this is quicker.

Organising data: Remind your child that data needs to be placed in specific parts of the block diagram (i.e. "salt" needs to be placed on the "salt" part in the following questions).

Monday 1st February	Watch online lesson 4 on tallying (revision) and making a bar graph. You can use the tally chart on the video or the pictures of condiments on Monday's worksheet to help you. You can remind your child that each bar stands for 2. Monday worksheet bar charts (condiments).
Tuesday 2nd February	Tuesday's worksheet - Pet bar chart Remember to answer in full sentences.
Wednesday 3rd February	Count in tens to 100 and back. Watch online Lesson 5 interpreting pictograms and bar charts. In Wednesday's Planets worksheet each  stands for 10. Write down how many people want to visit each planet. Look at the block diagram then read the questions. Your child should notice that not all the of the questions can be answered because the information is not on the pictogram. For example; <i>Which planet would my teacher prefer to visit?</i> Your child should answer the questions they can and explain why they cannot answer the other questions.
Thursday 4th February	Watch online lesson 4 again (if required). Look at Thursday's worksheet and discuss it. This time the blocks are horizontal and each one stands for 5. Ask the children to make up 4 questions that can be answered and 1 question that cannot be answered.
Friday 5th February	1. Spelling and number test, again mixing up the sums. Fun Friday! Let's play Top Mark games!!!
