

Week 3 Bees and Caterpillars

Boys and Girls,

Welcome to week 3 of home learning. This week we are looking at subtraction, minus, less than, in other words, take away sums. Again, we are going to use our known number facts to help us. We are going to look at ordering two digit numbers and begin to look at word problems. On Friday we have a problem solving activity.

Example: subtracting a 1 digit number from a two digit number

$$25 - 3 =$$

If I know $5 - 3 = 2$

Then I know $25 - 3 = 22$

Example: Adding tens

$$50 - 30 =$$

If I know $5 - 3 = 2$

Then I know

$$50 - 30 = 20$$

1. Use tap and clap rhythm to count in 10's to 100
 2. Use tap and clap rhythm to count in 5's to 100
 3. Use tap and clap rhythm to count in 2's to 50
 4. Use tap and clap rhythm to count in 3's to 30

Tuesday 19th January We are learning to use known number facts to add and subtract.	Add and subtract using known number facts. Remember If I know $5 - 3 = 2$ Then I know $25 - 3 = 22$ Complete Tuesday's worksheet. The sums are set out side by side and are linked to each other. Read across them as they are connected by known number facts. Use the left hand side to solve the right hand side.
Wednesday 20th January We are learning to order numbers.	Top marks game https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/subtraction-grids This is an ordering game. Go into the ordering section and the good thing is that you can choose different levels. https://www.topmarks.co.uk/ordering-and-sequencing/caterpillar-ordering Ordering Numbers Worksheet (choose one page) Order numbers from smallest to largest. Remind the children to look at the hundreds first, then the tens and then if they are the same compare the units. Write down the answers.
Thursday 21st January We are learning to solve addition and subtraction word problems.	Before Christmas we had started to look at word problems. Read through these questions with your child and highlight the important information. Solve the problems together and record the answers in a simple sentence e.g. There are 2 buses left. Complete Thursday's word problem worksheet.
