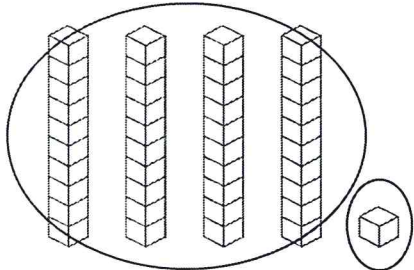
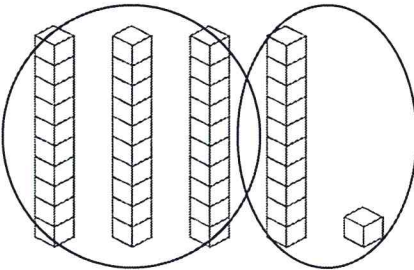
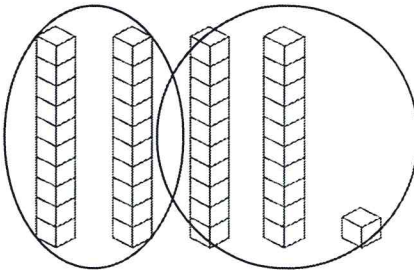


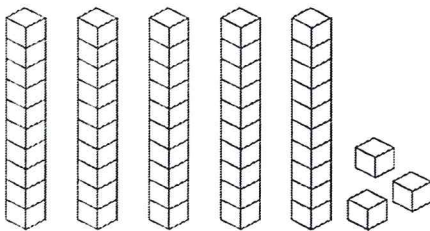
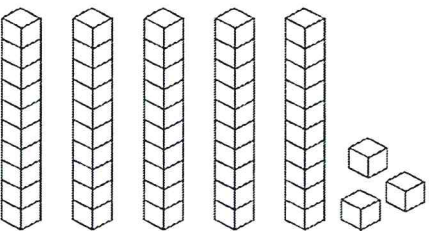
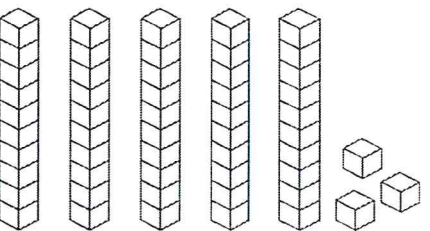
Complex Partitioning

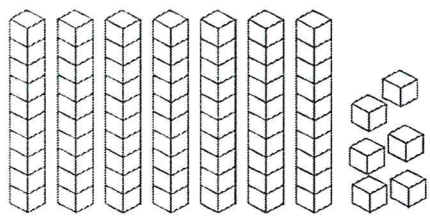
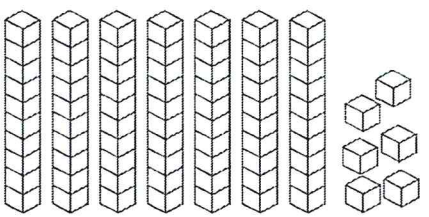
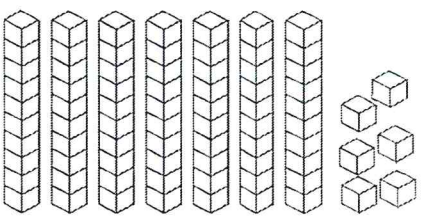
I can partition 2-digit numbers in different ways.
