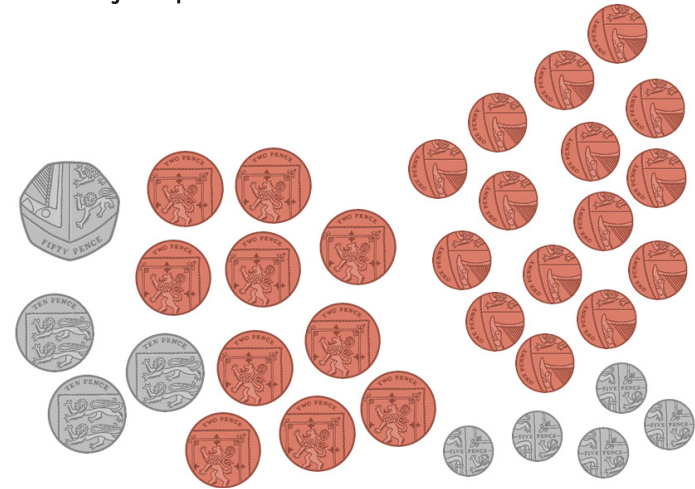

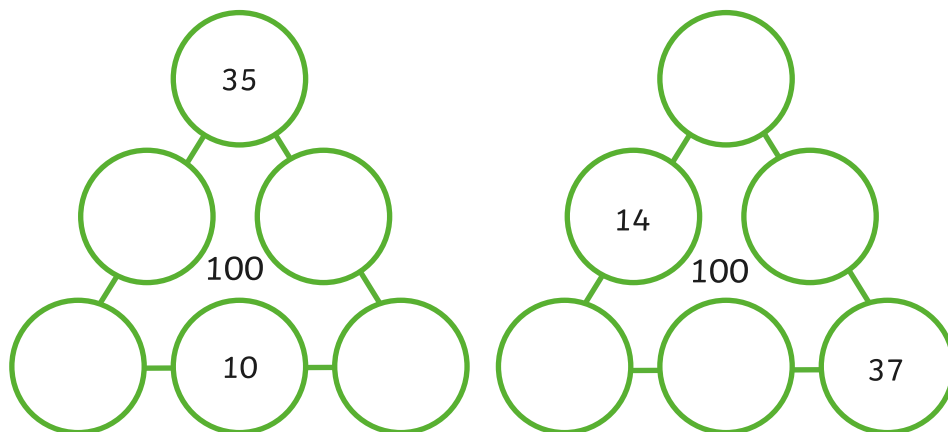

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Maths Mastery Addition and Subtraction Challenge Cards

1. If you add two even numbers together it will always make an even number. True or false? Show me how you know!

TRUE! If you add two even numbers together it always makes an even number. Examples include:

$$2 + 2 = 4$$

$$4 + 4 = 8$$

$$6 + 6 = 12$$

$$8 + 8 = 16$$

$$10 + 10 = 20$$

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Maths Mastery Addition and Subtraction Challenge Cards

2. If you add three odd numbers together it will always make an odd number. True or false? Show me how you know!

TRUE! If you add three odd numbers together, it will always make an odd. Examples include:

$$1 + 1 + 1 = 3$$

$$1 + 3 + 5 = 9$$

$$3 + 3 + 3 = 9$$

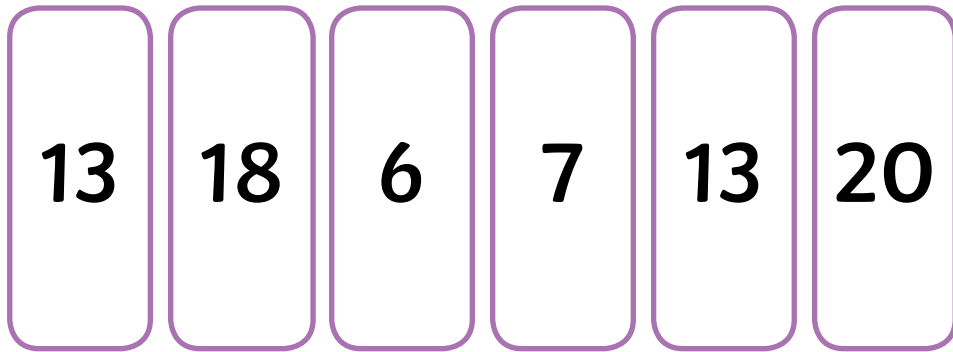

The number 36 can be split in many different ways:

6. How many different ways can you make the number 36?

Some possible examples:

$$\begin{array}{lll} 36 = 35 + 1 & 36 = 33 + 3 & 36 = 31 + 5 \\ 36 = 34 + 2 & 36 = 32 + 4 & 36 = 29 + 7 \end{array}$$

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Maths Mastery Addition and Subtraction Challenge Cards - Making Numbers

7. Try it with the number 24! How many different ways can you make 24?

Can you find more ways than your partner?

Some possible examples:

$$\begin{array}{lll} 24 = 24 + 0 & 24 = 22 + 2 & 24 = 20 + 4 \\ 24 = 23 + 1 & 24 = 21 + 3 & 24 = 19 + 5 \end{array}$$

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Maths Mastery Addition and Subtraction Challenge Cards - Consecutive Numbers

$$2 + 3 + 4 = 9$$

$$3 + 4 + 5 = 12$$

$$4 + 5 + 6 = 15$$

$$5 + 6 + 7 = 18$$

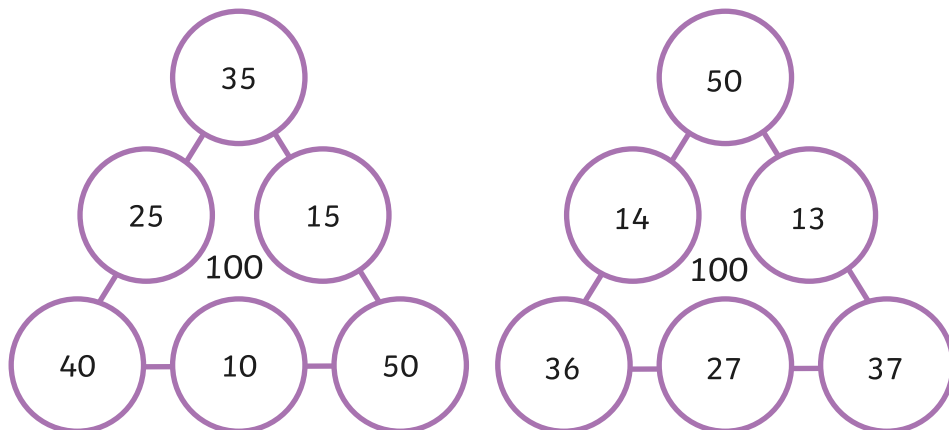
