At Greenway we offer high quality, affordable Sessional Day Care for pre-school children, from birth until their fourth birthday, as well as childcare provision for students and volunteers attending Greenway Women's Centre.

Greenway Sessional Day Care is operated by eight childcare workers. Greenway Childcare Staff are fully vetted by Social Services and trained in Childcare & Education, Child Protection, First Aid and Health & Hygiene.

In addition to this, our Childcare Staff regularly take part in further training in childcare-related courses to ensure that we continue to offer the best standards to your child at all times.

We are currently registered as a Sessional Day Care setting and not full Day Care and as such, there are some restrictions on the length of time your child/children can attend the Sessional Day Care in any one day.
