Equivalent Decimals and Fractions

$$0.5 = \frac{1}{2}$$

$$0.25 = \frac{1}{4}$$

$$0.75 = \frac{3}{4}$$

$$0.1 = \frac{1}{10}$$

$$0.2 = \frac{1}{5}$$

$$0.01 = \frac{1}{100}$$

$$0.33 = \frac{1}{3}$$

$$0.66 = \frac{2}{3}$$

$$1 = \frac{100}{100} \text{ or 1 whole}$$

* the key facts for the test for children in the Triangles and Squares are in black (the ones in red are there to extend their knowledge further)
