Square

- 4 equal sides
- 4 right angles
- 4 lines of symmetry
- opposite sides parallel

Rectangle

- 2 pairs of equal sides
- 4 right angles
- 2 lines of symmetry
- opposite sides parallel

Rhombus

- 4 equal sides
- no right angles
- 2 lines of symmetry
- opposite sides parallel
- opposite angles equal

Parallelogram

- 2 pairs of equal sides
- opposite sides equal and parallel
- opposite angles equal
- 0 lines of symmetry
