Angles in Shapes

The three angles in a triangle always add up to 180° .

The four angles in a quadrilateral always add up to 360° .

Turns

quarter turn = 90°

half turn = 180°

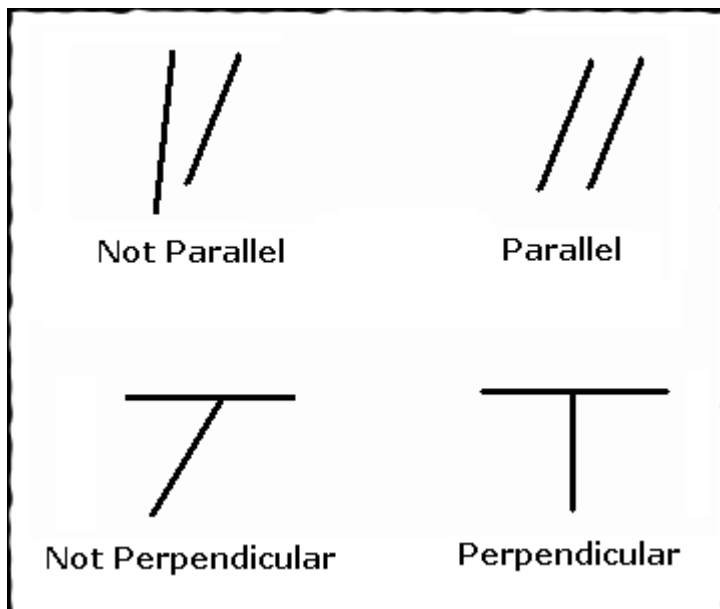
three-quarter turn = 270°

full turn = 360°

Parallel and Perpendicular Lines

Parallel lines are always the same distance apart and will never meet.

Perpendicular lines are at a right angle to each other (but don't have to be touching)



Volume of cuboids

The volume of a cuboid is calculated using this formula: length x width x height.
