Science Challenge

Balloon Racers



You will need a straw, cello tape, string and a balloon.

Step 1 - Tie one end to the string to a chair, door knob or other support.

Put the other end of the string through the straw.

Pull the string tight and tie it to another support in the room. Make sure the string is pulled tight.



Step 2 - Blow up the balloon but don't tie it.

Pinch the end of the balloon and tape the balloon to the straw (see the picture below)
