Spy Watch

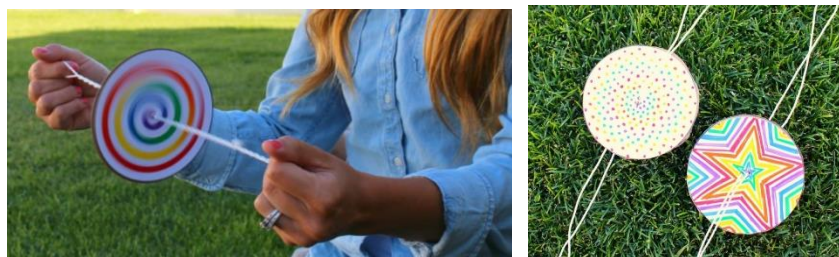
