Spy Watch

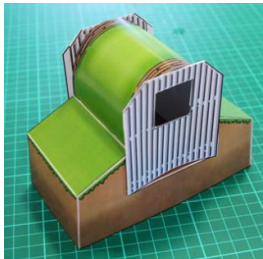
