Ice Sun Catchers



Materials Muffin baking tray/tin, string or wool, leaves, petals, pieces of chopped fruit, water.

Step 1 Place a piece of string into the muffin tray.

Step 2 place your leaves and petals into the muffin tray and fill with water. Add food colouring if you wish.

Step 3 Place in the freezer for a couple of hours.

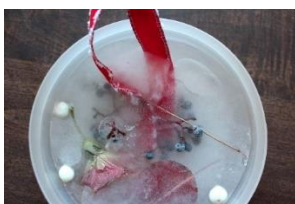
Step 4 Remove from the freezer and hang from a tree. Watch the sun light bouncing off the ice.
