Spy Watch

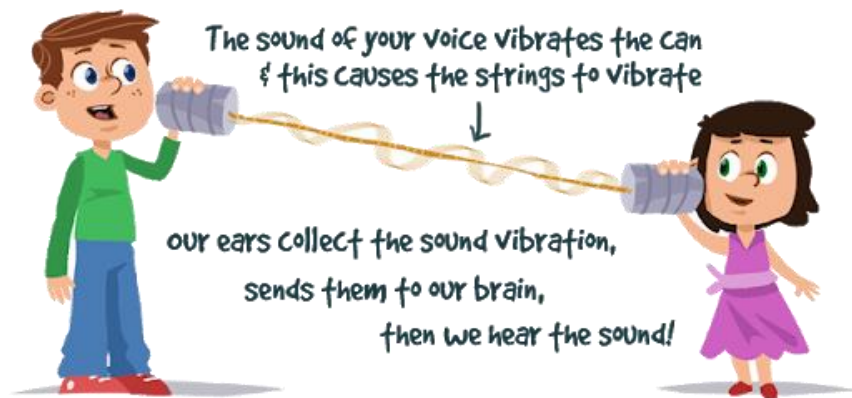
