## Ice Sun Catchers



**Materials** Muffin baking tray/tin, string or wool, leaves, petals, pieces of chopped fruit, water.

**Step 1** Place a piece of string into the muffin tray.

**Step 2** place your leaves and petals into the muffin tray and fill with water. Add food colouring if you wish.

**Step 3** Place in the freezer for a couple of hours.

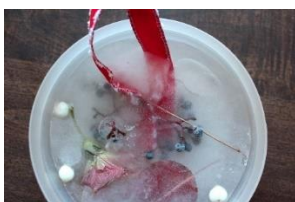
**Step 4** Remove from the freezer and hang from a tree. Watch the sun light bouncing off the ice.

How long does it take to melt?

Is there a difference on sunny and cloudy days?



**Alternatively** If you want to go **bigger** you could use a cake tin and a plastic cup or a plastic bowl and ribbon.



Or if you want to go **smaller** use ice cube trays.
